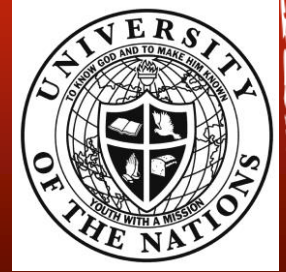


# Teachers For the Nations
